FINE ON PUBLIC WI-FI

LOW-STAKES, EVERYDAY USE



BROWSING, NEWS, AND MAPS
Ordinary reading and navigation are fine.



**STREAMING AND
EMAIL READING**
Use normally. Watch for fake prompts.

PHONE DATA ONLY

TURN WI-FI OFF FIRST



BANKING OR BROKERAGE
Use your mobile connection
before you sign in.



SHOPPING CHECKOUTS
Switch to phone data before
entering card information.



WORK-CONFIDENTIAL TASKS
Keep sensitive work activity
off public Wi-Fi.



PASSWORD CHANGES
Use phone data before changing
an account password.

NEVER, ON ANY NETWORK



DO NOT ENTER A PASSWORD
on a page a popup sent you to.



DO NOT GIVE A WI-FI PORTAL
your email password or credentials.

A marketing email address is one thing. Your password is not.
IF A LOGIN PAGE ASKS FOR A PASSWORD, WALK.

WI-FI OFF / USE DATA / TURN WI-FI BACK ON AFTER
